| Purpose                         | The Oklahoma Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task<br>Force is a multi-agency, multi-jurisdictional initiative, funded with<br>a grant from the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency<br>Prevention (OJJDP). Its mission is to deter, prevent, investigate and<br>prosecute predators who seek to exploit or engage minors in sexual<br>activity through the use of computers and the internet. The ICAC<br>task force is a joint operation in which agencies act as partners and<br>includes investigators and supervisors from various local, state and<br>federal law enforcement agencies who provide assistance subject to<br>availability. Each participating agency is to make available its<br>resources (workplace and equipment) in support of a joint Task<br>Force investigation and agrees to provide wages and benefits for its<br>personnel assigned to the Task Force. Agencies will provide<br>information and guidance to the public through presentations. Task<br>Force members will be provided advanced training and grant funds<br>may be used to finance the training, subject to the availability of<br>funding for this purpose. |
