The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation wants to make you aware of law changes that occurred in the last legislative session that impact the current SDA Law Book.

SIGNED BILL INCLUDING SDA LAW BOOK SECTION IMPACTED	CHANGES MADE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 2022
SB 1802 TITLE 21 O.S. §1290.18 – APPLICATION FORM CONTENTS	Consolidated the two version of the statute into one.
SB 0186 TITLE 21 O.S. §1283 – CONVICTED FELONS AND DELINQUENTS	It removes language that prohibits a person convicted of a felony from riding as a passenger in a motor vehicle in which there is any pistol, imitation or homemade pistol, altered air or toy pistol, machine gun, sawed-off shotgun or sawed-off rifle, or any other firearm. It removes language that prohibits a person previously adjudicated as a delinquent child or a youthful offender for the commission of an offense, which would have constituted a felony offense if committed by an adult, from riding as a passenger in a motor vehicle. It clarifies the definition of the term "sawed-off shotgun" or "sawed-off rifle".
HB 3070 TITLE 21 O.S. §1289.13A – IMPROPER TRANSPORTATION OF FIREARMS	Clarifies language related to transporting a firearm in a motor vehicle.
